#### **AMBULANCE & VEHICLE DRIVER/OPERATOR**

The driver will drive the ambulance to transport sick, injured, or convalescent persons and also drive other vehicles to do hospital errands.

#### **Key Responsibilities & Duties:**

- Be able to work in a twenty four (24) hour environment and maintain a positive and enthusiastic attitude.
- Carry out routine checks on the vehicles.
- Be able to detect and report malfunctioning of the vehicle systems.
- Ensure the ambulance is ready to receive patients.
- Drive skillfully to avoid sudden motions detrimental to patients.
- Assist the medical team to load or offload patients from the ambulance.
- Ensure security and safety for the vehicle on and off the road.
- Ensure safety of the passengers and/or goods therein.
- Maintain cleanliness of the vehicles and its components at all times.
- Maintenance of work tickets for vehicle assigned.
- Have general knowledge in motor vehicle and ambulance operations.
- Remove and replace soiled linens or equipment.
- Accompany and assist emergency medical technicians on calls.
- Provide first aid or rescue assistance in emergencies.
- Report facts concerning accidents or emergencies to hospital personnel or law enforcement officials.
- Restrain or shackle violent patients.
- Assist in booking transport.
- Assist in the front office and reception when not driving.

#### **Minimum Requirements:**

- Secondary school certificate with good spoken English and Kiswahili.
- Valid certificate of good conduct from the National Police Service.
- Valid classes BCE driving license.
- Minimum of five (5) years' working experience as an ambulance driver with good track record.
- Must have passed the drivers' test including being in possession of a valid PSV.
- Valid Basic Life Support certificate and/or First Aid course certificate from a recognized institution.
- Defensive driving course.
- Ambulance operator course certificate.
- Good general understanding of the different vehicle parts / vehicle care maintenance.
- Good understanding of the local laws applicable to driving emergency vehicles.
- Emergency Medical Training (EMT) will be an added advantage.
- Assessment test by the AA driving school is an added advantage.
