HOSPITAL VISITORS RESTRICTION POLICY

March 16th, 2020.

In response to the presence of COVID-19 in Kenya, effective Tuesday 17th March 2020, M.P Shah Hospital is implementing a restricted visitors policy.

Number of allowed visitors will be limited

- Adult visitors with symptoms of fever, cough or flu-like symptoms should not visit hospital patients.
- The Hospital will henceforth limit visitors to **the listed one next of Kin** per adult patient in the ward. **Visiting schedule will strictly be 5.00pm-7.00pm for a period not exceeding 45 minutes.**
- No minor family members or visitors, ages 12 and under, will be allowed in to visit in the adult wards
- The Children's Hospital at M.P Shah Hospital is limiting visitors to 2 parents or guardians for a hospitalized child. There will be no visitors under age 12 allowed. In the outpatient only 2 visitors are allowed to accompany the sick child.

Access points to hospitals and clinics restricted

- As M.P shah Hospital continues to take preventative measures for our patients, families, visitors and health care teams, we are restricting access points at our hospitals and clinics.
- There will be security personnel posted at the entrances to direct patients, families and visitors to the designated access points to diagnostic and treatment centres.
- All hospital staff members must display their hospital badges for ease of access to the hospital premises.
