REPORT THE DANGER SIGNS IMMEDIATELY AND VISIT A&E FOR URGENT CARE.



For **Diabetics/Pregnancy Diabetes**, regular sugar monitoring is paramount. Visit A&E immediately should you have any danger signs or uncontrolled sugars in pregnancy and contact your doctor.



Patients with **hypertension** before/during pregnancy should carefully measure their BPs as often as possible & follow DR's instructions. High blood pressure is a risk to the mother and the baby's health!

DANGER SIGNS AFTER GIVING BIRTH INCLUDE ABC-S ALONG WITH THE FOLLOWING:

Fevers post delivery, malodorous/excessive vaginal discharge or bleeding, discharge from surgical site, swelling of hands and face, calf pain, pain/difficulty in voiding bladder, one leg swollen more than the other.
